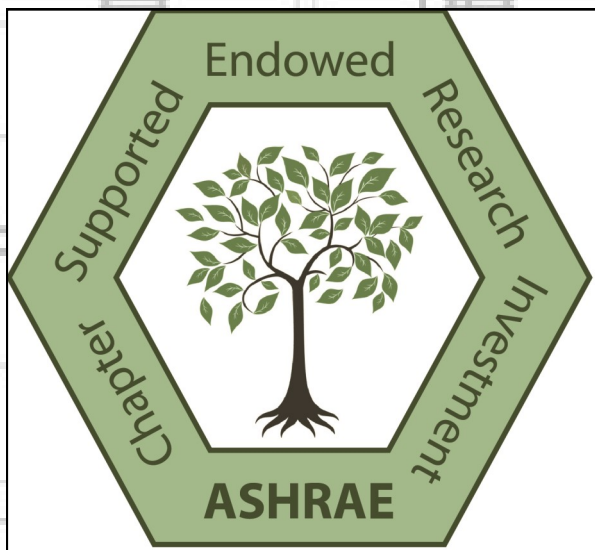

**ATLANTA (Mar 5, 2018)** – Registration for the free ASHRAE Webcast, “Making Energy Efficiency a Reality,” is now open at [www.ashrae.org/webcast](http://www.ashrae.org/webcast). There is no fee for registration. However, registration is required to view the free webcast.

The webcast will broadcast live on April 19, 2018, from 1-4 p.m. EDT, and is available to registrants on demand from April 20 – May 4, 2018. This webcast is offered by ASHRAE’s Chapter Technology Transfer Committee (CTTC).
