

DOE Report on Cybersecurity Threats

DOE last week released a report that identified areas where government and industry officials need to better prepare for cyber-attacks. The report said the U.S. is "well prepared to manage most electricity disruptions" but highlighted how grid resilience efforts suffer because of "gaps in incorporating cybersecurity concerns, including planning for long-term disruption events, into state emergency response and energy assurance planning." The report is a result of an executive order signed by President Trump last year requesting reports from government agencies on cybersecurity vulnerabilities. The DOE also has a new Cybersecurity, Energy Security and Emergency Response office which was created to address cyber vulnerabilities in the energy sector.

President to Order Assistance for Coal and Nuclear Power Plants

The Trump Administration has ordered Energy Secretary Rick Perry to take steps to assist failing coal and nuclear power plants on the basis that closure would be a risk to national security. According to a draft 41-page internal memorandum dated May 29, the administration wants operators to buy the electricity from plants at risk of retirement and also establish a "Strategic Electric Generation Reserve" with the aim of promoting national defense and maximizing domestic energy supplies. A planned Energy Department directive would use federal emergency authority under both the Federal Power Act and the Defense Production Act to order grid operators to purchase electricity from coal and nuclear plants in an effort to help those plants compete against cheap natural gas and renewable sources. Also the memo says gas "pipelines are increasingly vulnerable to cyber and physical attacks," which could "have severe effects on electric generation necessary to supply critical infrastructure facilities."
