
## RP Campaign 2018!!

#### **EU To Finalize Energy Efficiency Goals for 2030**

EU energy ministers met on June 11 to discuss an energy efficiency directive that sets targets for 2030. EU negotiators informally agreed last week on a binding target to source 32% of the EU's final energy demand from renewables, including specific measures to increase renewable energy use in heating, cooling and transport. However, talks have now faltered over 32% vs 33% renewable energy use. According to COGEN Europe, the amount of energy lost in the production and distribution of electricity reaches an average of 60%, a figure which can reach 75% for power plants running on biomass (sun and wind power are considered to generate no losses). The lost energy is usually released as steam, which is typically seen coming off from the giant cooling towers of electricity plants.

#### **Canadian Prime Minister Appoints New Climate Ambassador**

Justin Trudeau, Prime Minister of Canada, announced the appointment of Patricia Fuller as Canada's new Ambassador for Climate Change. This appointee, announced on World Environment Day, will be tasked with advancing Canada's clean growth and climate change priorities on the world stage.
