

ASHRAE President Provides Written Testimony to Florida Building Commission

ASHRAE President Sheila J. Hayter provided written testimony to the Florida Building Commission (FBC), which is considering updates to the statewide energy code. President Hayter urged the FBC to incorporate by reference the most recent version of ANSI/ASHRAE/IES Standard 90.1, *Energy Standard for Buildings Except Low-Rise Residential Buildings*, which is the 2016 version, including all of its appendices as a compliance path for that state.
