IMPORTANT Government Outreach Update

On behalf of the Chapter Board of Governors, we wanted to provide information on the recent House Bill (HB6) that passed out of the State House and to the Ohio State Senate. The Senate will complete their session on June 26th on this topic and it is expected to move quickly. The bill, as it stands, could have a large impact on our industry. In preparation of this, ASHRAE Society Staff drafted a letter that could be sent to state senators (<http://www.ohiosenate.gov/senators/district-map>).

In lieu of signing the letter, developed by ASHRAE staff, on behalf of our membership, the board has decided to share the letter with membership and urge you to act as you see fit. Please find it along with this newsletter and feel free to modify it for your own personal response to the bill.
