# Florida Introduces Bill on Cooling Towers and ASHRAE Members Provide Technical Input

In December 2019, Florida Senator Gruters introduced a bill that would require owners of cooling towers to register them with the Department of Health, and would require the owners obtain or update a maintenance program or plan for these cooling towers. ASHRAE members have responded to questions from the Florida Department of Health about this legislation and have offered additional technical assistance. In particular, thank you to Robin Bryant, former GAC member, and Director and Regional Chair for ASHRAE Region XII for engaging with this outreach.

#### West Virginia School District Adopts 50% AEDG



The Kanawha School District in West Virginia adopted the 50% AEDG K–12 Guide as the design guidance for the \$95 million renovation project. ASHRAE members in West Virginia met with this school district, which serves over 25,300 students, and encouraged this improvement in energy efficiency for the schools. Thanks in particular to former GAC member Art Hallstrom who took a leadership role in this effort!

# **Netherlands Supreme Court Rules Government Must Cut GHG Emissions**

On December 20, the Supreme Court for the Netherlands ruled that the country must cut green-house gas emission (GHG) by 25% from benchmark 1990 levels in 2020. The Netherlands has also committed to a 49% reduction of emissions by 2030 compared to 1990 levels. The court ruled that the government must reduce emissions since it had a legal obligation "to protect the lives and well-being of citizens in the Netherlands."

#### **Germany's Parliament Passes Law to Ensure Climate Goals**

In Germany, the Bundesrat (the upper house of Parliament), approved <u>a climate law</u> that aims to help the country hit its 2030 emissions reduction goal. The law, which was passed by German parliament's lower House in November, went into effect on January 1 and creates a national emissions trading system for the transport and building sectors.

#### Maryland Rolls Out Clean Energy Proposal

Maryland Governor Larry Hogan has rolled out the Clean and Renewable Energy Standard, or CARES, as part of the state's effort to move toward renewable energy sources. The proposal would maintain the state's renewable energy requirements of 50% by 2030 and 100% by 2040 and bring nuclear power into the fold of renewable energy. Additionally, the bill would create new Clean Energy Resource Credits that would only be available to facilities in Maryland that generate electricity through nuclear power, combined heat and power, natural gas or burning biomass. The 90-day General Assembly in Maryland began on January 8.



#### Congress Passes an End of Year Spending Bill

Congress avoided a government shutdown by approving a \$1.4 trillion spending bill that was signed by President Donald Trump. The bill includes a \$2.9 billion increase for the Department of Energy including a 26% boost to its Buildings Technologies Office. Additionally, tax incentives for energy efficiency were extended in a year-end tax package attached to the spending bill; the incentives are retroactive and are extended through the end of 2020. This includes 179D, a tax deduction that sets incentives for building owners that reduce their building's total energy and power cost by 50% or more in comparison to past versions of ASHRAE Standard 90.1.

#### Bipartisan Legislation Introduced in the House to Phase Down High-GWP Refrigerants

On January 7, U.S. Representatives Paul Tonko (D-NY-20), Pete Olson (R-TX-22), Scott Peters (D-CA-52), and Elise Stefanik (R-NY-21) introduced H.R. 5544, the *American Innovation and Manufacturing Leadership Act of 2020*, which would require a 15-year phasedown of high global warming potential (GWP) HFCs in the U.S., beginning in 2020. This bill is a companion measure to S. 2754, a bipartisan bill introduced in the Senate in October. ASHRAE has provided letters in support of the legislation and has offered technical assistance.

#### **EERE Issues Funding Opportunity Announcement for Innovation Projects**

The U.S. Department of Energy Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE) has issued a \$40 million funding announcement for innovation projects that cover key agency priorities, such as critical materials, energy storage, grid integration, water security, and cybersecurity. #### **House Republicans Host Energy and Environment Innovation Showcase**

On December 9, Republicans on the House Energy and Commerce Committee hosted an <a href="energy">energy</a> and <a href="energy">environment innovation showcase</a> "to highlight the importance of investing in the development and deployment of breakthrough technologies to reduce emissions, power the economy of tomorrow, and provide greater value to American consumers." <a href="The event">The event</a> featured companies, universities, and other organizations from members' districts. In advance of the event, Republicans listed <a href="12">12</a> bipartisan bills they could work on in 2020 to reduce emissions and promote clean energy.

#### 285 Companies Agree to Meet Low-Emission Targets

On December 4, the Science Based Targets Initiative announced that 285 companies agreed to meet targets for lower emissions that correspond with the current goals of the Paris climate accord. It is projected that these commitments could drive an estimated \$18 billion in climate mitigation funding and 90 terawatt hours of renewable generation each year. Participants include Microsoft Corp., Coca-Cola Co. and McDonald's Corp. Additional companies continue to pledge emissions reductions.
